Cuvée La Mouline – 2010



Produced from a selection of old vines composed of 45% Cabernet Sauvignon and 55% Merlot. This cuvée is only produced from very ripe vintages in limited quantities of between 600 and 2400 bottles.

It aims to be comparable to the wines of the classified "grands crus" of Pauillac, our close neighbours. This cuvée is aged in 70% new barrels for 12 months

TASTING NOTE

- Colour : Deep garnet
- Nose : Good aromatic harmony between wood tannins and very ripe red berries
- Palate : Powerful and structured with candied fruit aromas. A rich, concentrated and complex finish.
- A potential aging time of 25 years
